## Monthly CMS Ranking Report

Here is June's CMS Ranking Report for all State Directors. Congratulations to David MacDonald (Kentucky), Cheryl Ann Gilmore (South Carolina), Eddie Middleton (Tennessee), Ruben J. Uriarte (California), John Ventre (West Virginia), John Skare (Kansas), Donald R. Burleson (New Mexico), Jim King (Iowa), Bland Pugh (Florida), Steve Firmani (Massachusetts), Lorna Hunter (South Dakota), Augustine B. Fawkes (Idaho) for being at 100%!!! The top 10 State Directors are highlighted in yellow.

The report is based on our two measures of UFO Investigation effectiveness. Assigning reports within 72 hours of receipt, and completing all investigations within 90 days of being assigned. The "**Assigned**" column is a six month running average of the number of cases assigned within 72 hours divided by the total number of cases received in that six month period. The "**Completed**" column is the number of cases completed beginning sixtytwo (62) days back and going back six months from there (for a total of eight months back) divided by the total number of cases reported in the same period. The "Weighted Rank" is just the average of the two columns expressed as a percent.

To improve your score be sure to assign all cases within 72 hours, and follow-up with your Field Investigators to ensure all reports are completed within 90 days. To be considered complete a report must have been investigated and placed in one of the three completed status codes (Unknown, Hoax or IFO) by you the State Director.
